## Sustainable Sydney 2030 consultation

Sustainable Sydney 2030 has been an ongoing project since 2007. In the past 12 months the City of Sydney has held:

- Four business forums
- Four community forums
- Two 2030 community workshops
- Numerous meetings with State Government agencies
- Two 2030 leaders workshops
- Five ATSI 2030 Consultations
- Three City Talks with guests and residents invited from City of Sydney area
- Eight 2030 roundtable discussions with key stakeholders
- A 2030 seminar at Live Green in August 2007, which attracted 10,000 people

In addition

- The 2030 Future Phone visited 27 locations in the City Centre and inner city suburbs in 2007 and early 2008 receiving more than 2000 messages from the public on visions for Sydney 2030.
- More than 15,000 people visited the Sustainable Sydney 2030 website
- More than 4,000 people have been directly consulted through meetings, forums and interviews.
- City of Sydney commissioned SGS Economics and Planning, in conjunction with Envirometrics and Australia Street Company to undertake a 2030 Research Survey. It was a two-part web-based survey, in October and December of 2007, surveying 500 people in each survey who live or visit Sydney.
- Conservatively, more than 10,000 people have been directly informed of Sustainable Sydney 2030 messages through events and festivals such as City Talks, Live Green and the Future Phone.

During the Sustainable Sydney 2030 public exhibition there will be:

- Two free public City Talks with world-renowned speakers.
- Three City Conversations
- Two Indigenous Consultations
- Website access
- A public Exhibition of the draft strategy from April 17 - May 31 at Customs House in Circular Quay.
